Satyarup Siddhanta is one of the World's leading mountaineers, currently holding the **Guinness world record** of being the Youngest in the world to climb both - the highest Mountain and highest Volcanic summits of all 7 Continents in the World

As a child, he was severely asthmatic and worked extensively to overcome the odds to realize his mountaineering dreams.

He did his BTech from Sikkim Manipal Institute of Technology and is working as a solutions architect (software) consultant in Bangalore.
